# TALK IT OVER

### How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group, or pod, or family turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin by discussing key questions, read the Scriptures together, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps, and your follow up study plan.

### Main Idea for this week:

Standing for God's truth will guide us no matter the circumstances of life.

### Key Questions:

- In the crisis, What were the 3 of the steps Daniel took?

- Do you have a group of Christ follower friends who you can contact in the crisis to pray for you? If so, you might send them a note of thanks today. If not, this may be a great time to join a group.
- As soon as God answered Dan and his friend's prayer, what was Dan's response?

Daniel 2:19b \_\_\_\_\_

- Have you found times when it's difficult to share God's truth with someone? How did Daniel overcome that concern when he shared the dream interpretation with King Nebechendezzar despite fear of Neb's response?

Read Daniel 2:34-35, 2:44-45. See also Luke 20:17 and 1 Peter 2:4-8

- Who or what is the rock Daniel refers to?
- The book of Daniel shows us that all kingdoms will come and go, but God's kingdom will never end. Read Lamentations 5:19 and Daniel 4:3. What comfort does that give you?

- What steps will you take this week to Stand True to God's Word?
