TALK IT OVER

How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group, or pod, or family turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin by discussing key questions, read the Scriptures together, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps, and your follow up study plan.

Main Idea for this Week:

Until you understand your weakness, you won't appreciate God's strength.

Use these questions to get started:

- Talk about a time you prayed for something and God answered your prayer, or a time
 you prayed hard for something, but you felt it wasn't answered the way you wanted it.
- What's your prayer life like right now? Hit-and-miss? Thriving? Non-existent? How would life be different if you were confident that God cares about you?

Key Questions:

- Read Daniel 10:17-19. Tell about a time when you were in a weak place in your life and you needed to call on God. Did you go to God, or try to get through it on your own?
- Read Daniel 10:2-3. Have you ever fasted anything while you were praying; in order to be closer to God, and to show your humility before Him?

Next Steps:

• What are you currently praying and believing God for? How can the group pray about this for you? How might your prayers be different from before?
