- Chairs will be grouped into family/friend units with space around them, so you can sit with your family or friends you come with or hang out with. Please have your kids sit with you. We will have much lower seating capacity than usual.
- We love your kids! Unfortunately, Nursery and Countryside Kids are unavailable at this time. Please have your kids stay with you. Join us for our Wednesday night outdoor family-oriented services available May 27, June 10, June 24
- Sunday Services will be about 50 minutes long
- After services, please exit through the closest exit to you (including side door emergency exits)
- Bathrooms will be available, wipes are available, please wash your hands, please no more than two people in the restroom at a time.
